They do a very good job singing this song and it is a great start to their project. "The Blood Will Never Lose Its Power" is a classic song in the history of Southern Gospel Music and Joyful Noise does an exceptional job on this beautiful song about the power and the reach of the Blood of Jesus Christ. The next song on this project is a song that I just became aware of a little over a year ago even though the song has been around a little while. The song is "Wonderful Merciful Savior" and this version of this song is simply outstanding! I really enjoyed this song and it quickly became a favorite. The tempo picks up a little with "Everything's Gonna Turn Out Right." What a great message in a song reminding us that no matter what we are going through, with Christ, everything is going to turn out right!
