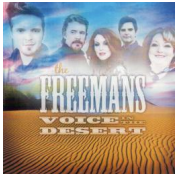


## Freemans - Voice In The Desert

Their latest project is titled "Voice In The Desert" and this is a very good and very special project from the Freemans.

The title song, "Voice In The Desert" is the first song on the project and I love this upbeat song that challenges us as believers to be that voice in the desert for the unbelievers in our life!
