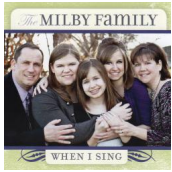


## Milby Family - When I Sing

The next song is written by group members Robin and Tess Milby and "You Are On The Inside" is a phenomenal song that reminds us that we can have great peace on the inside because that is where Jesus lives!
