One of the modern Christmas classics is a song that came out a few years ago titled "Grown Up Christmas List." This song has a beautiful sentiment of some of the things we wish for our world as an adult. Lindsey does a great job with this Christmas favorite. "O Come O Come Emmanuel" is the next song on this project and this recognizable song has a beautiful melody and lyric which I know will bless the listener. Of course, when we think of Christmas we think of those many Christmas carols that we grew up singing in church.
