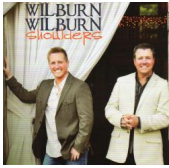

While quartets and family groups are still quite prevalent, there are many other groups and soloists that are making their way into the industry and finding quite a bit of success. One of those artists is Wilburn and Wilburn. The father and son team have a project called “Shoulders” and it is a very enjoyable collection of Southern Gospel Music.

The project begins with an upbeat song titled “This Wouldn’t Be The Same Song.” This song is a perfect reminder of how much different our life would be without Jesus in it. I know I would hate to think where I would be without Him. “It’s What He’s Done” is the next song on the project and this beautiful ballad reminds us that “it’s not what we do but it is what He’s done.” What a great message! The tempo picks up with “Love Without End, Amen” and this song reminds us that God’s Love never ends and we can always depend on it.

I absolutely love the next song! It says “Sin Is No Match For Grace” and I am sure that you can tell from the title that it has a great message. The upbeat tempo is wonderful as well and the message is tremendous as it reminds us that God’s Grace can cover any sin. The next song is what I sometimes refer to as a “thinking” song. What I mean is that the song makes you stop and think.
